

US Military CYPRES Maintenance

(Regarding Recommended Maintenance Press Release)

On April 28, 2016 Airtec released a Press Release that the civilian CYPRES maintenance is turning from mandatory to highly recommended. This Press Release will be issued to some other country's Militaries as well.

However, the CYPRES maintenance policy for the US Military will remain unchanged. We do not advise anyone to skip the maintenance since it offers many advantages, but due to a growing number of issues with shipping, customs fees and even corruption in some countries we felt that something had to be done.

There are two primary aspects to a reliable AAD. The first is based on how well the unit is produced. The second is based on scheduled maintenance. Some people in these countries tend to have a lower safety threshold. By choosing to have a CYPRES they have a reliable product, and if they skip the maintenance it is still reliable, but not as reliable as it could be. Everyone draws the line somewhere when it comes to safety and the amount of risk they are willing to accept. We have seen this mind set in the civilian side, and although most people realize the importance of maintenance, there are many that do not.

Since the US Military environment is different and safety standards are set higher, the CYPRES maintenance for all models remains mandatory.
